



Bass Drum Spur Drilling Template for DF # BS06

Note: Spurs may look identical but there is a **left** and **right** spur. The spur is on the correct side when the leg points straight toward batter head when folded back against the shell.



1. Decide where you want to mount the bass drum spurs - have your lug holes marked or drilled first.

2. Use the solid lines to align with the bearing edge.

3. Use the dotted lines to place spur in relation to the lug holes.

4. This template works with both the left and right spurs. Tape template to shell using painter's blue tape. Mark and drill with 9/32" drill.

If the template seems too large or small, make sure that Adobe Reader is printing at 100%
